THE GREETING

THE CHRIST IS REVEALED TO THE MAGI

Arise, shine; for your light has come and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you. Nations shall come to your light and Kings to the brightness of your dawn. They shall bring gold and frankincense and shall proclaim the praise of the Lord.

The Wise Men / Magi are placed in the Crib

What gifts are fitting for Christ our Lord?

Bring gold for the King of the nations who rules us in justice and peace.

Bring frankincense for the Son of God who reveals the Father's love.

Bring myrrh for the Son of Man who shared our sorrows and died for our sins. Blessed be God for ever.

PENITENCE

The story of the Wise Men challenges us about our commitment to God:

When we have grown tired of searching for truth or seeking God's will, **Lord, have mercy.**

When we have strayed from the command to love and serve our neighbour, **Christ, have mercy.**

When we have offered less than the best in our worship and service of God, Lord, have mercy.

May almighty God who sent his Son into the world to save sinners, bring us his pardon and peace, now and for ever.

O God, who by the leading of a star manifested your only Son to the peoples of the earth: mercifully grant that we, who know you now by faith, may at last behold your glory face to face; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

THE MINISTRY OF THE WORD

Isaiah 60: 1-6

First Reading

Arise, shine; for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD has risen upon you. ² For darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but the LORD will arise upon you, and his glory will appear over you. ³ Nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn. ⁴ Lift up your eyes and look around; they all gather together, they come to you; your sons shall come from far away, and your daughters shall be carried on their nurses' arms. ⁵ Then you shall see and be radiant; your heart shall thrill and rejoice, * because the abundance of the sea shall be brought to you, the wealth of the nations shall

come to you. ⁶ A multitude of camels shall cover you, the young camels of Midian and Ephah; all those from Sheba shall come. They shall bring gold and frankincense, and shall proclaim the praise of the LORD.

Second Reading

Matthew 2: 1-12

2In the time of King Herod, after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, wise men* from the East came to Jerusalem, 2asking, 'Where is the child who has been born king of the Jews? For we observed his star at its rising,* and have come to pay him homage.' 3When King Herod heard this, he was frightened, and all Jerusalem with him; ⁴ and calling together all the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Messiah* was to be born. ⁵They told him, 'In Bethlehem of Judea; for so it has been written by the prophet: 6 "And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who is to shepherd my people Israel." 7 Then Herod secretly called for the wise men and learned from them the exact time when the star had appeared. ⁸Then he sent them to Bethlehem, saying, 'Go and search diligently for the child; and when you have found him, bring me word so that I may also go and pay him homage.' When they had heard the king, they set out; and there, ahead of them, went the star that they had seen at its rising,* until it stopped over the place where the child was. ¹⁰When they saw that the star had stopped,* they were overwhelmed with joy. ¹¹On entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother; and they knelt down and paid him homage. Then, opening their treasure-chests, they offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. ¹²And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they left for their own country by another road.
